

EXTERNAL LANDFORM

SHA QI (杀气)

Have you ever entered a home or a building and felt uneasy for no apparent reason? The presence of Sha Qi could be responsible for this. Sha Qi, which refers to negative Feng Shui or attacking energy, is the result of inauspicious landform features.

Even though it's invisible, Sha Qi can often make one feel uncomfortable. In more serious cases, Sha Qi can affect your luck cycle. Prolonged exposure can also compromise your physical and mental well-being.

Here are the **INAUSPICIOUS LANDFORM FEATURES** to avoid.

1 IRREGULAR PLOT OF LAND



Before buying your home, check that it's been built on a square or rectangular plot of land. An irregular piece of land with a broad front and narrow rear, for example, will have the following implications: massive outflow of wealth, leading to a difficulty in accumulating wealth, and a lack of credibility for its occupants.


2 WIND GAP SHA (天斩煞)



Wind Gap Sha, or 'cutting blade', is defined as the gap between two buildings. Wind is allowed to penetrate this gap, generating undesirable attacking energy

against the rooms in the facing units. The occupants of these rooms will face health issues that may lead to surgery.

3 WALL KNIFE SHA (壁刀煞)



Wall Knife Sha, also known as 'poison arrow', is defined as the sharp edge of the building pointing towards your home. Having a Wall Knife Sha will result in many challenges in your life such as a loss of wealth, a lawsuit and even family disharmony.



Wall Knife Sha can also refer to anything with a sharp edge pointing towards your main door or your body (pictured above). The principles of Emperor Landform states that “墙头冲门，常被人论”，meaning if the main door faces the Wall Knife, it will cause conflicts and

gossips at work or at home. Family members will also be more prone to neck-related issues, car accidents or finance-related problems.

If the rear or side of the home has Wall Knife Sha, occupants may face issues from malefactors, extra-marital affairs and even financial troubles caused by their relatives.

4 T-JUNCTION SHA (路冲煞)



If your building or main door is facing a T-junction, then you're susceptible to T-junction Sha. Encountering the T-junction Sha will bring about widespread implications, from poor health to eye-related diseases to an increased risk of traffic accidents. A home with T-junction Sha will also not bode well for your children's academic results.

5 CURVED BLADE SHA (镰刀煞)



You will be affected by the Curved Blade Sha if you have a curved road pointing towards the front of your building. It's deemed as one of the most serious types of Sha Qi because Qi is 'deflected' from the building,

depriving its occupants of luck. As such, occupants who are under the effects of Curved Blade Sha tend to suffer financial losses, abdominal health issues and accidents. In more serious cases, they may lead to surgery and major illnesses.

6 SUPPRESSION SHA (压迫煞)



The golden verse "两高夹一低，一世被人欺" states that if a building is flanked by two taller buildings, its occupants will tend to experience more malefactors at work, decline of family fortunes and a lack of motivation to succeed in life. So be careful of which building you choose to call home!

6 WHITE TIGER SHA (白虎煞)



In Chinese metaphysics, the right side is defined as White Tiger, while the left side is defined as Green Dragon. According to the golden verse, a building is said to be afflicted with White Tiger Sha if there's a taller building located to its right.

White Tiger Sha creates situations in which the women in the household over-dominate. As a result, occupants tend to experience disharmony within the family. The male members also tend to be henpecked.

7 FLOWING WATER SHA (流水煞)



Water can be defined as rivers (physical water) or roads (virtual water). In modern context, when a building is positioned directly above a driveway, it's deemed to have a Feng Shui formation known as '水破天心', or water breaking the heavenly heart. The building is therefore afflicted with Flowing Water Sha, which creates financial problems, attracts malefactors and causes disharmony and major health issues for the occupants.
